 - Emergency Physicians and Nurses able to deal with any mental health or addiction emergency.
 - o Psychiatrist on call
- 3 Police and Crisis Team- PACT
 - o 9:00am-9:00pm, 7 days a week.
 - Team consists of a Psychiatric Nurse & RCMP Member.
 - If not an emergency call the Main ICAT line: 587-259-5513 (Please note this is not a crisis line and you may have to leave a message).
 - In an emergency, call 911.

Services not offered at ICAT:

- Completion of forms, such as: AISH, Insurance or WCB.

Mental Health services are voluntary unless criteria is met that the person is in imminent danger to themselves or to others.
